

BAKING IDEAS

Hot Rod Racer

Ingredients

- Sausage
- Finger Roll
- Tomato Sauce
- 4 thick slices of cucumber

Method

1. Have the centre of the finger roll cut down the middle, fry or grill the sausage
2. Draw the racing driver on a piece of card. Cut him out and stick on an ice-lolly stick on the back with sticky tape.
3. When the sausage is cooked put it in the finger roll and position the cucumber slices at the sides as wheels.
4. Squirt tomato sauce in a wavy patter along the top of your sausage.
5. Stick the driver in the hot rod racer to serve

Apple Owl

Ingredients

- ½ apple
- 1 orange slice
- 2 dried apricots
- 2 raisins
- 1 grape
- Chocolate sauce

Method

1. Cut the apple in half. Remove the core and seeds.
2. Slice the bottom and top off so that the end is flat.
3. Cut your orange slice in half to make 2 triangles and secure it to the side of your apple with sauce.
4. Dip the flat side of your apricots in the sauce. These are the owl's eyes.
5. Dip each raisin in the sauce. Place one in the middle of each of the apricot eyes.
6. For the beak, stick the halved grape in the centre.

Mushrooms

Ingredients

- 4 cold hard-boiled eggs
- 2 medium tomatoes
- 3 tablespoons cream cheese
- 2 boxes cress

Method

1. Peel the eggs
2. Slice the tomatoes in half and scoop out the seeds with a spoon.
3. Put a small dot of cream cheese inside the tomato and then stick it on top of the egg.
4. Put a small dot on the bottom of the egg and stick it to the plate.
5. Put little dots of cream cheese all over the tomatoes and make the spots.
6. Chop the cress with scissors and arrange it around the plate to look as if the mushrooms are growing in the grass.

Ice Cream Clowns

Ingredients

- Tub of ice-cream
- Ice-cream cones
- Cup-cake cases
- Sweets

Method

1. take a scoop of ice-cream and put it in the cup-cake case.
2. Quickly make a face in the ice-cream by pushing sweets into the front to make a face

Fruit Skewers

Ingredients

- Apples
- Grapes
- Cherries
- Different types of melon
- Mango
- Pear

If using apples or pears put in a bowl and sprinkle with a little orange / lemon juice to stop them turning brown.

Method

1. All you have to do is chop up the fruit and scrape out any seeds.
2. Push the chunks on to the skewers one after the other so they look colourful.

Mice in jackets

Ingredients

- Potatoes
- Radishes
- Cherry tomatoes
- Spring onions
- Raisins
- Grated cheese
- Milk
- Butter

Method

1. Bake the potatoes (this can be done before hand)
2. Cut off the tops and carefully scoop out the inside of the potato.
3. Mash the potato with butter, milk and some of the cheese and then put back into the potato.
4. Sprinkle the cheese over the potato and reheat under the grill for a short time.
5. Decorate the mouse – tomato for the nose with spring onions for the whiskers, raisin eyes radish ears and spring onion tails.
