*“He was born in an obscure village The child of a peasant woman He grew up in another obscure village, where he worked in a carpenter shop until he was thirty when public opinion turned against him. He never wrote a book. He never held an office. He never went to college. He never visited a big city. He never travelled more than two hundred miles from the place where he was born. He did none of the things usually associated with greatness. ... Nineteen centuries have come and gone and today Jesus is the central figure of the human race, and the leader of mankind's progress. All the armies that have ever marched, all the navies that have ever sailed, all the parliaments that have ever sat, all the kings that ever reigned, put together have not affected the life of mankind on earth as powerfully as that one solitary life.”*

While nailed to the cross Jesus said seven things that were remembered and later written in the Gospels. We are going to think about three of these sayings:

**Luke 23v34.**

**John 19v30.**

Isaiah 53v5–6

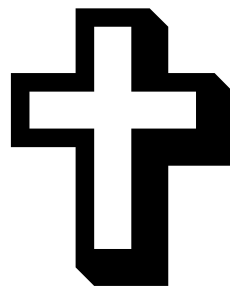
From these words what can we say the death of Jesus has done for us?
