**Alan: Someone else's trousers on?**

Mr. Mackey.: If I had 7 apples in this hand and 9 apples in this hand, what would I have?

**Reece: Great big hands!**

Mr. Mackey: Right then....**Mark you haven't answered yet**, I am going to ask you a VERY simple math question. If you had five pound coins and I asked you to give me 2 of them, how much would you have left?

**Mark: Oh I'd still have 5 pounds! I'm not giving you any of my money!!**

**(Kyle strolls on stage)**

Mr. Mackey.: Kyle, why are late for class?

**Kyle: I left home late.**

Mr. Mackey.: Why didn't you leave home earlier?

**Kyle: Because it was too late to leave earlier.**

Mr. Mackey.: Kyle, this is the fifth straight day you've been late to class. What do you have to say for yourself?

**Kyle: Boy, am I glad it's Friday!!**

**Alex: Sir, I'm going to miss school on Monday because I'll be home sick.**

Mr. R.: Why, are you feeling sick?

**Alex: I'm not now, but I will be after my Dad sees this test score.**

Mr. Mackey: Alex, You missed school yesterday. You're missing too much school!

**Alex: No I'm not! I stay home and play video games. I don't miss school at all!**

Mr Mackey: Right that's it.....you lot are so badly behaved today you're staying in at break time for some extra studying!

**All of class: Awwwwwww Sir!**

(James starts to snore loudly)

Mr. Mackey.: **James!!** Are you awake!?

**James: (rubs his eyes) Well now I am!!**

(Frazer looks over at another paper)

Mr. Mackey.: **Frazer**, I hope I didn't see you looking at your neighbour's test paper.

**Frazer: I hope you didn't either!**

Mr. Mackey.: OK, now let's settle down and get ready for some history questions. Now, class, what do George Washington and Abraham Lincoln have in common?

**James H: They're both dead.**

(Mr Mackey shakes his head)

Mr. Mackey.: **Reece**, you don't ever raise your hand. Are you having trouble hearing?

**Reece M: No, I'm having trouble listening!**

Mr Mackey: Cheeky boy!

Mr. R.: **Alex**, Where was Queen Elizabeth crowned?

**Alex: On her head!**

Mr. Mackey.: Can anyone name all the states in USA?

(Silence)

Mr. Mackey.: No one? When I was your age, I could name all the states.

**Tyler: Yeah, but there were a lot less states when you were our age.**

Mr. Mackey.: Where was king Henry VIII buried?

**Josh: In the ground?**

Mr. Mackey: NO! He was buried at St. George's Chapel. Can anyone tell me WHY he was buried at St. George's Chapel?

**Adam: Because he was dead?**

**Kyle: Sir, I have a question.**

Mr. Mackey.: Does it have to do with history? I don't want any silly questions.

**Kyle: No, this is a real question about history.**

Mr. Mackey.: OK. What's the question?

**Kyle: Which English King invented the fireplace? (pause) Alfred the Grate.....**

(class begin to laugh)

Mr. Mackey.: OK, stop laughing! That's not funny! Let's talk about some of yesterday's tests and test scores. **Adam**, did you think the test questions were hard?

**Adam: No, the questions were easy. It was the answers that were hard.**

Mr. Mackey.: **James H**, I had trouble reading your test because your handwriting is terrible. I think you need to learn to write neatly.

**James H: Sir**, I already know how to write neater.

Mr. Mackey.: Well then, why don't you do it!?!?!

**James H: If I wrote neater, you'd see that I can't spell!**

Mr. Mackey.: Well then maybe you should buy a dictionary.

**James H: Nah I'll wait for it to come out on DVD.**

Mr. Mackey.: Spelling isn't that hard. Let's do an easy word. How do you spell school?

**James H: S - K - U - U - L?**

Mr. Mackey.: That isn't how it's spelled in the dictionary!

**James H: I thought you asked me how I spelled it!**

Mr. Mackey.: **James!!** Wake up!! You act like you don't want to be here. Do you not like going to school?

(Bell goes)

Mr. Mackey.: OK. That's the bell for break. Earlier I told you that everyone had to stay in for break, but I've changed my mind. I don't know why I'm doing this, but I'm going to let all of you go to break.

**Tyrone: Sir**, I know why you're going to let us go for break.

Mr. Mackey.: Why is that, **Tyrone**?

**Tyrone: Because it's a nice thing to do, and old people always do nice things.**

(Boys rush out the door laughing and yelling. Mr Mackey put his head against the desk in frustration. End of show.)
