




Professor Norman C Nevin OBE 'Adaptive and Visionary'



Professor Norman Nevin became President of the Northern Ireland District of The Boys' Brigade in 1992. He was already widely known and respected for his clear Christian witness, his academic gifts of scholarship, particularly in genetics, teaching and leadership, and personal attributes of vision, enthusiasm, and encouragement. In a short time these and a host of other qualities and abilities were freely used in the interests of Boys' Brigade in Northern Ireland.

Norman was a member of 75th Belfast Company and came to faith, in Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour, at a BB Bible Class, going on to achieve The King's Badge.

As President he enjoyed being with Boys and Young Men, in various settings; Company Displays, Competition Finals, National Competitions, and KGVI Training Courses. He was an excellent ambassador of BB. He chaired meetings with a gentle but firm touch, and guided business with wisdom and grace. He was adaptive when change was needed and visionary when it seemed that there was the danger of getting stuck in a rut. Beyond all this was his commitment to 'keep the main thing the main thing' – giving priority to advancing Christ's Kingdom among Boys. Prof Nevin was determined that this should be foremost in our thinking, planning and doing.

Norman always enjoyed supporting and attending Junior Section events and competitions in which he took a keen interest. In recent years he particularly enjoyed the Musician of the Year competition often getting similar results to the adjudicator. Mrs Nevin accompanied him on many occasions, also taking great interest, and we remember her especially at this time.

Junior Section Musician of the Year

This annual competition is now in its 10th year and has proved to be very popular and successful. Talk to your Junior Section boys and encourage them to consider entering.

RULES

1. The competition is open to all Junior Section Boys (school years P5/6/7) for solo voice or solo instrument. One entry only is permitted from each boy.
2. Each boy's performance should last at least 1 minute and not longer than 3 minutes in total. The piece(s) played are of the boy's own choice.
3. An accompanist or accompaniment, if required, should be provided by the competitor.
4. Entries should be forwarded on the entry form not later than Monday 15 December 2014 to BB NI Headquarters at Newport (address on entry form):
5. There is an entry fee of £2.00 per boy, which should be enclosed with the entry form.
6. The Competition will be held on Saturday 17 January 2015 at 1.45pm in, Templepatrick Presbyterian Church Hall.
7. Results will be given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places.
8. The winner of the competition will be awarded the Robert Renwick Cup.
9. Further details, along with a programme, will be forwarded to the Officer named on the entry form, in early January.
