## Potted Sports

Details of Battalion Heats will be available from your own Battalion who will be responsible for organising and running the Heat.

**NO PREPARATION or PRACTISING is NECESSARY**

### RULES...

1. Each Section may enter 1 team which consists of 6 boys of Junior Section age (P5/6/7). Please note that a maximum of 6 boys may be brought to the competition.
2. Each team should be accompanied by an Officer. Officers will be asked to assist with the supervision of one of the challenges.
3. PE Kits should be worn during the competition. T-shirts advertising alcohol should not be worn.
4. For the Battalion Heats there will be 8 Potted Sports Challenges. The number of challenges in the Final will depend on the number of teams competing in the Final.

## Swimming Gala 2015

The Swimming Gala will be held on **Saturday 21 February 2015** in the Orchard Leisure Centre, Armagh at 2.00pm (*check-in and start times will be confirmed on programme*). An Entry Form is enclosed which must be returned by **Monday 2 February 2015** to NI Headquarters at Newport.



**ENTRIES:** Age-limits are as follows...  
 GROUP A 9 years or under on 1 July 2015 (P5 school age)  
 GROUP B 10 years or under on 1 July 2015 (P6 school age)  
 GROUP C 11 years or under on 1 July 2015 (P7 school age)

### RULES:

1. Boys may swim in ONE age-group only – Anchor Boys and Boys under 8 years of age are not permitted to take part.
2. Boys may only compete in TWO out of the three individual events within their own age-group. It is not possible to swap events on the day of the competition.
3. Each Junior Section may enter ONE Relay Team of 4 Boys, with each Boy swimming one length of the pool Freestyle.
4. All entries must be accompanied by the appropriate fee of 80p per Boy for each individual event and £1.50 per Relay Team.
5. The CLOSING DATE for entries is **Monday 2 February 2015**.
6. Officers should ensure that Boys are entered in the correct age-group.

A programme will be sent to the Officer-in-Charge of each Swimming Team.

**AWARDS:** Medals will be presented to the Boys/Relay Teams with the 1st/2nd/3rd fastest times in each event. The Northern Bank Cup will be presented to the Company with the highest points in the competition.

5. Team will rotate round each of the Potted Sports Challenges. The time period for each challenge, both in the Battalion Heats and in the Final, will be 4 minutes.
6. The scoring system will be on a points basis, based on the number of entrants ie. if there are teams competing then the winners of each challenge will get 8 points, 2nd will get 7 points, 3rd 6 points etc. The overall winners will have the highest points score. In the event of a tie for the overall winner, the team with the greatest number of 1st places will be declared the winner.
7. The Final will be confined to the winners of Battalion Competitions. Battalion finalists should be notified to Sharon Mackey, by Battalion reps to the NID JS Committee, not later than **Monday 9 March 2015**.
